

Recycled Book Making with Seattle Recreative



- 20-30 sheets of standard Letter-sized (8.5"x11") copy paper, can be any color/ pattern and can be reused junk mail, old copies, etc.
- Either 2-4 pieces of cardstock, construction paper, stiff piece of color or decorative paper with fun design for the book covers, also 8.5x11", OR you can use a thin cardboard cereal box.
- An awl or hammer and nail to punch holes into our books.
- Piece of scrap wood or other firm material so that the awl/nail won't hurt the surface you're working at.
- Sewing needle and thread (a duller upholstery needle is ideal, but any standard sewing needle will work)
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors for cutting paper
